Lost Sheep Series by Andrew McDonough	4-10 years	These bright and colourful books explore parables, bible characters or biblical ideas (We are the branch and God is the vine) in a super engaging and easy way for kids to understand. They even come with the bible passage from where the story is from, and questions to ask before, during and after the story.
Here Comes Heaven by Bill Johnson and Mike Seth	8-12 years	The kids' version of When Heaven Invades Earth, a powerful book by Bill Johnson, Senior Pastor of Bethel. This book is an invitation for young people to bring the realm of Heaven to earth! As children discover their identity through the revelation of the Father's love, they are released to fulfill their Royal Mission: to demonstrate the Kingdom of God by living a life of miracles.
Here I am, the One you Love by Stephanie Schureman	6-12 years	A beautifully illustrated book that looks at what it means to live in the presense of God and in a deep relationship with their Papa.
Loving Our Kids on Purpose by Danny Silk	For Parents	Loving Our Kids on Purpose brings the principles of the Kingdom of God and revival into our strategy as parents.
Heaven is for Real by Todd Burpo	3 years to Adults (because there are different versions)	With three versions, Heaven is for Real for Little Ones, For Kids, and the original adult version (which our preteen and teenagers could read), this book tells the real life story of Colton who visited Heaven, and came back with one important message: Jesus really, really loves children.
