CONNECT: Welcome and celebrate together

PRACTICE: 'SEE' reflective activity [[PDF](#)] [[MP3](#)]

READ: Philippians 3:1-14

- Look for aspects of Pauls 'why' in this passage.
- In this passage where do you see examples of Paul thinking and living really intentionally as a disciple of Christ?
- What inspires or challenges you about these words of Paul?

DISCUSS: Take time to unearth the real 'why' of your life in the following areas: (*this is harder than you think!*)

- Why am I a Christian?
- Why am I in this Small Group?
- Why do I do the job I do? (this may be paid or voluntary equivalent employment or activity, including stay at home parenting)

Try and articulate it in one or two sentences, maximum, to your Small Group. And don't stress if you can't quite get the words right! Just have a go at speaking it out...
