## Faithful One Teaching Overview

We will be looking at the life of Abraham in Genesis 12-25 and using Hebrews 11:8-19 that provides a commentary to Abraham's example of faith. But He is not the one we refer to as the Faithful one - it's God! The story of Abraham is a powerful example of God's commitment to be in covenant with His people, and that it is His faithfulness that maintains it, not our own righteousness. God is the promiser maker, promise keeper, and even fulfills out part of the covenant as promise fulfiller. There is powerful foreshadowing in God's test of Abraham, where God provides the lamb for the sacrifice, just as He provides the Lamb for our sacrifice. In this series, we hope our children will understand that **God is faithful to keep His promises, and therefore we can have faith in what He says is true.**
