We consider this a wonderful opportunity for those seeking to grow in their leadership and practical ministry skills and encourage applicants who have prior experience working in our church's children's ministry (though not essential). Interested applicants can be from our Peakhurst or Chipping Norton sites.

Please note this role includes Sunday hours (4 hours for our fortnightly Sunday gathering week and 2 hours for small groups weeks), with the remaining hours used to prepare for program during the work week.

This role will oversee the River kids program at CN gatherings, including the preparation, facilitating and leading of our small team. This also includes the facilitation of our kids engagement activities during our community connect lunch. The other main responsibility will be assisting two of our CN small group to meaningfully engage our children in those small groups and foster rich intergenerational experiences.
