This role will be part of our case work team that works with our wider team to provide pathways leading to wholistic transformation. Our programs include community relief, food hampers, emergency relief, legal support, arts programs, all with a priority for connection and relationship.

About the role- Permanent Part Time

The Role of the Case Manager is to work with the Senior Case Manager and case work team to provide care and support for Life Care clients with complex social needs who, in addition to the support available through Life Care, may benefit from more specialised advice and referral to external agencies.

Care and support is provided as an expression of Christian faith.

The role also involves managing an appointment schedule at our centre in Peakhurst. You will be planning and providing support, advice for individuals and families with complex needs including referral to other internal or external services as required.

Works with Senior Case Manager and CEO to plan and facilitate Case Management Services in professional, effective and God honouring manner. The role also includes the administration and distribution of Emergency Relief funds to clients in financial crisis as per the funding agreement with DSS (Department of Social Services).

You will also be required to maintain referral partnerships with external organisations and participate in the triage and intake process of new clients alongside the team.
